Tyler Howell inventoried what supplies we have at the plant for water line repairs and he is going to order some more supplies to make sure we are set for any repairs that may come up.

The EPA would like the Village to measure chlorine and Rob Shoaf stated he would contact Wigen to have them look over our system and see if there is a way to measure chlorine. Tyler Howell stated he would contact Spencerville plant and see how they are set up to measure chlorine.

Tyler Howell requested permission to purchase a 2 way radio to use during breaks and other tasks when multiple people are working on a project throughout town.
