THE VILLAGE OF LARUE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OR STORAGE OF
UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLES OUTSIDE OF A BUILDING
WHETHER ON VILLAGE STREETS OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
LONGER THAN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS.

WHEREAS; There have been numerous complaints concerning the storing of motor vehicles in varying states of disrepair, many of which are incapable of operating under their own power, outside of buildings in said Village and which do not display a current and valid Ohio license plate registered to said vehicle, and;

WHEREAS: There is no current legislation in said Village prohibiting such practice;

THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of LaRue, Ohio, that the storing or keeping of any motor driven vehicle which does not display a current Ohio license plate registered to said vehicle, outside of a building in said Village whether it be on Village streets or on private property, for a period, either consecutively or accumulatively, in excess of fifteen days shall be prohibited;

Any person violating the foregoing provision will be subject to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent offense. Any such violation shall constitute a separate offense on each successive day continued after notification that there is non-compliance with this ORDINANCE.

This ORDINANCE is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that it provides for the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the Village of LaRue, Ohio and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately eliminate certain dangerous conditions prohibited by this ORDINANCE and as such emergency measure this ORDINANCE shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives a two-thirds majority vote of all the members elected to Council, otherwise it shall become effective at and after the earliest period allowed by law.
