

ORDINANCE 2013-4

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 2013-4 OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS TO INCREASE THE SEWER BASE RATE TO \$25.00 PER MONTH AND THE USAGE RATE TO \$5.25 TO COVER INCREASED OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE COSTS INCURRED BY THE VILLAGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of LaRue, State of Ohio:

WHEREAS the Council for the Village of LaRue, Ohio has received Resolution No. 2013-2, unanimately, passed by the Board of Public Affairs on 1-21-13 to cover costs incurred by the Board for the Village of LaRue Sewer System:

WHEREAS the current base rate for sewer is \$23.00 and the requested rate increased is to \$25.00 per month;

WHEREAS the current usage rate for sewer is \$4.75 and the requested rate increased is to \$5.25 per month;

WHEREAS the Board of Public Affairs is responsible for operation and maintenance of the sewer system for the Village of LaRue and based upon their determination that the requested increase is the minimum amount necessary to perform their responsibilities the Village Council finds the imposition of this increase in sewer rates is equitable upon all premises and residents supplied with sewer by the Village of LaRue, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT APPROVED by the Council for the Village of La Rue, Ohio that the base rate for sewer supplied by the Village shall be \$25.00 per month, to take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT APPROVED by the Council for the Village of La Rue, Ohio that the usage rate for sewer supplied by the Village shall be \$5.25 per month, to take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the Village of La Rue, Ohio and the inhabitants thereof and for the further reason that it is necessary for the daily operation of said Village; and as such shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor provided it received the required three readings and the affirmative vote of a majority of the members elected to council or otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
