Old Business-

Hydrant in front of the church needs replaced because after the fire at 121 N High Street it is broken and is shut off at the valve. A motion was made by Justin Wall to get a replacement hydrant with a second by Doug Shawver.

GPD engineering group is still work on grant options and other financials for the Village for the water tower. The firm mentioned getting another quote on the water tower by another company and it would not cost the Village anything. The Board was made aware that Mt Victory has done some tower painting and repairs so Clerk Mary Price is going to contact them and see what the cost was.

Water leak out by La Rue Kenton Road was the customers responsibility and the Village will only be billed for 2 ½ hrs of dig time.

Kiwanis meter still needs to be replaced so the board would like Wendy Crabtree to make contact with Tom Tucker to see what the status is with ML tech Services.

New Business –

Lead testing has all been taken to meet the EPA requirements and all households that were tested have been notified of the results within two business days.

Tom Ford presented that the line at the end of South High Street has a broken valve that he would like repaired so the line can be cleaned out properly. Tyler Howell is going to look into what valve is needed to get it replaced.
