- Anti-scalant pump has not be installed yet he is waiting on Wogens still.
- Tom Myers repaired the tractor air conditioning unit and it is working properly now.
- Sand filters are still running in manual mode at the plant.
- GPD made all the changes to the Vine Street project that was discussed at the last meeting.

Update on the patch in front of the Methodist Church is that Clarence Greer is going to contact the State on 6/15/20 to find out when it will be completed.

The Board approved the Vine Street project plans.

Diane Evans reported that she made some phone calls regarding the sewer loan and Richwood Bank is willing to process a loan but the interest rate is not where it would be beneficial. Mount Victory bank said since they are a state bank and the dollar amount is so high (over 1 million) they would not be able to help. Diane reported that she still has more phone calls to make and will update at the next meeting.

New Business –

The Board all agreed that starting in July the board would start implementing the monthly late fee after the 15th and then start shutoffs again.

Tyler Howell will be out of town in July and Steve Kendall will cover for him at the plant.
