<u>The financial report</u> – Dave Albert made a motion to approve the bills with a second by Diane Evans, motion passed. Diane Evans made a motion to approve the meeting minutes with a second by Doug Shawver, motion passed.

Old Business -

Tyler Howell reported that he has 3 different pro types for the air actuators completed and still testing them all out. The price per dozen is roughly \$300.

Tyler Howell reported that Core & Main has reported that they are starting to get more meters and we are on the list for a dozen once they arrive.

Tyler Howell reported that he will contact S.A. Comunale Company to schedule a backflow inspection for the hatchery and J-Lenco.

Diane Evans reported that she sent an email to Access Engineering about the status of things at the plant and about purchasing new filters. Access reported that 90% of the engineering is completed, but they have not heard anything from the commissioners about paying the engineering cost. An email was sent to Evie to see if she heard anything from the commissioners and she had nothing to report. At this point it is unknown what the commissioners are doing even though they approved to cover the engineering costs. Diane is going to talk with Terry in the county building in the coming week to find out what the Village needs to do and if there are any updates.

Residents are starting to notice iron again in the water so another set of filters need to be purchased. A motion was made by Dave Albert to purchase a new set of RO filters with a second by Doug Shawver, motion passed.

New Business –

Jennifer Young was present to discuss with the board about the rust in her water when she filled her pool. Tyler Howell reported that the levels are still high but within acceptable levels so a solution would be to flush hydrants in the area.

Tyler Howell reported that a break occurred with a 2-inch line behind Michael Fields by the railroad tracks. The 2-inch tap saddle part was very difficult to locate so the break repair took several days until the part could be located. The parts for a 2-inch lines are very difficult to locate so some parts that were located have been purchased to have on the shelf.

Tyler Howell reported he will be out of town this month so Steve Kendall will be completing all the testing. He went over some items at the plant and reviewed all the supplies that are in the van for possible issues that may come up.
