<u>New Business</u> –

Scott Ballenger was present to talk with the Board and give an update one year into operating the water infrastructure. The following report was given:

- 140 meters have been replaced in town and 12 more remote readers need to be installed
- Aqua wants to get a couple valves replaced before winter throughout town
- No new services over the past year
- One water main break reported
- Installed a clear well inlet valve
- Numerous metering pumps were replaced in the plant that weren't working
- Fixing issues with wells and they had to abandon well #3 and they have now drilled well #5
- The plant can now be monitored from Marion and a security system has been installed
- \$282,000 of improvements have been completed
- Last fall all the hydrants were flushed and they all worked. Next flushing will be the end of September or early October

Scott reported that Tyler Howell has been great to work with and Mary Price has been very responsive with correspondence.

Tyler Howell reported that the Market Street pump station hour meter is not reading and he has contacted Marion County Sanitary regarding the matter. The issue started on August 20th.
