January Meeting

Old Business –

Evan Long quoted \$687 per mowing at the Lagoons so the Board is going to table the matter until next month so more information can be gathered. Typically, the Lagoons need to be mowed around 3xs per year.

The High Street pump station had the transducer replaced and is running correctly now. The cost of the part is unknown at this time. Additionally, this same pump station was having issues on 1/26/26 and it appeared to be a generator issue, but no further information is available. Marion County came out to service the station.

The Board reviewed the water fund CDs and year to date \$22,727.99 has been accrued. Options to use the interest earned on Village projects was discussed, but nothing was decided at this time.
